The Division is aware that some policyholders may not have the ability to complete the rebuild of a total loss home due to a wildfire within the insurer's policy timelines. The purpose of this Bulletin is to inform insurers of the Division's position concerning delays in claim handling for policyholders who have suffered a total loss during a catastrophic disaster, which may further delay rebuilding of the property.
